

Maintenance Mechanic - Regina West

Essential Responsibilities:

- Ensures operation of machinery and mechanical equipment by completing preventive maintenance requirements on engines, motors, pneumatic tools, conveyor systems, and production machines; following diagrams, sketches, operations manuals, manufacturer's instructions, and engineering specifications; troubleshooting malfunctions.
- Removes defective parts by dismantling devices; using hoists, cranes, and hand and power tools.
- Controls downtime by informing production workers of routine preventive maintenance techniques.
- Inspect electrical systems, equipment, and components to identify hazards, defects, and the need for adjustment or repair, and to ensure compliance with codes. Advise management on whether continued operation of equipment could be hazardous.
- Maintains equipment, parts, and supplies inventories by checking stock to determine inventory level; anticipating needed equipment, parts, and supplies; placing and expediting orders; verifying receipt.
- Install and repair electrical systems, apparatus, and electrical components of industrial machinery and equipment, following National and State codes, equipment manuals, schematic diagrams, or blueprints while using proper hand tools and test equipment.
- Has working knowledge of all or some of the following: electrical/electronic circuits, PLC's, wire installation/termination, conduit threading, bending and installation, AC and DC motors and controls, and welding.
- Diagnose and replace faulty mechanical, hydraulic, and electrical components of machines and equipment.
- Strong electrical and mechanical aptitude for troubleshooting equipment issues, while minimizing downtime.
- Documents equipment condition in computer database, adding new equipment and planning preventative maintenance schedules to keep equipment in top condition. Prepares reports by collecting, analyzing, and summarizing information and trends.

- Maintains safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations.
- Must have the ability to manage multiple tasks and prioritize to ensure minimum interruption to production activities.
- Perform semi-skilled and unskilled laboring duties related to the installation, maintenance, and repair of a wide variety of equipment.
- Ability to meet deadlines while working under stressful situations.
- Operate mobile equipment including forklift, manlift, scissorlift, and overhead cranes.
- Other related duties as assigned.

Requirements:

- Industrial Mechanic Millwright certification
- Five years or more prior experience as a mechanic in a manufacturing environment required
- Background in mechanical repair in industrial, heavy truck, automotive, or farm equipment
- Must be able to read and understand schematics, blueprints, and ladder diagrams
- Proficient in the use of computers including MS Office, Excel, Word, and Outlook
- Must possess light mechanical maintenance skills
- Possess excellent problem solving and root-cause analysis skills
- Must have physical strength, hand-eye coordination and endurance. Must also be able to concentrate on their tasks.
- Good verbal and written communication skills.
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and show initiative.
- Demonstrate thoroughness and attention to detail with a strong sense of urgency.
- Team player and highly self-motivated individual.
- Valid Driver's license required.

- Must be able to work in an environment with continuous exposure to outdoor weather conditions with dust, fumes, and noise. Must be able to climb, stoop, bend repeatedly, work in confined spaces, carry hand power tools, and pass company physical including pulmonary function test and drug screen.
- Must be 18 years of age or older as evidenced by a picture I.D. and legally authorized to work in the country position is located in.
- Willingness to comply with pre-employment screening, including but not limited to drug testing, reference verification and background check.

Preferred:

- Knowledge of operation of mechanical equipment
- Basic understanding of hydraulics and pneumatics is a plus
- Secondary education in machine repair or machine shop preferred
- Experienced maintenance electrician in a production setting preferred
- Licensed to perform electrical work in the province of Saskatchewan
